

Curate and codify core teaching techniques for impact across the curriculum.



Program overview

Developing shared instructional language is not easy. In this year-long digital program, you will work with Bron and her team to think carefully about the instructional language you want to develop across your school. You'll be given the time, knowledge and resources to curate and codify a set of core instructional techniques that matter to you.



What is an instructional playbook, and what is it for?

An instructional playbook is an organisational tool used to support professional improvement. At its most simple, it's a curated collection of core teaching techniques that all teachers can use. Instructional playbooks can support professional learning with whole staff (e.g. workshops), with teacher teams (e.g. PLCs) or with individuals (e.g. peer observations/coaching).

The process of writing an instructional playbook will encourage you and your team to think collectively about the teaching practices you value. By the end of the engagement, you will have developed a unique instructional resource that can inform improvement efforts, streamline professional learning offerings, support instructional coaching, and bring precision to the professional conversations your teachers have every day.

Who is this program for?

This program is designed for primary and secondary school leadership teams – including Principal Class and Middle Level Leaders (e.g. Heads of Faculty, Learning Specialists, Leading Teachers, PLT Leaders). Classroom teachers are also encouraged to join.

Is this a good fit for my school?

While any school is welcome to participate, you will get the most out of this program if you:

- Want to develop instructional clarity to support your programs of professional learning or instructional coaching
- Are committed to developing precise, shared instructional language across teams and year levels
- Are committed to providing professional development to enhance teachers' knowledge and practice
- Want to develop more explicit and responsive pedagogical approaches across the curriculum

This program consists of 4 x 2.5-hour digital workshops (via Zoom), and a commitment of 6-8 hours of structured, self-paced tasks to be undertaken throughout the year. As you move through the program, you will enjoy targeted support from Bron and her team.
